

Transfer FTM 2019 to A New Computer

Transferring **FTM 2019** (Family Tree Maker 2019) to a new computer is a straightforward process, but it requires careful attention to detail to ensure that all your genealogical data is successfully migrated. FTM 2019 is a popular software tool for tracking family history, so whether you're upgrading to a more powerful machine or replacing an old one, maintaining the integrity of your data is critical. To begin, you'll need to ensure that you have a backup of your Family

Tree Maker files. You can easily create a backup of your entire tree, including media files, by using the "Backup" function in the software. Make sure that you save this backup to an external storage device like a USB drive, or even cloud storage, to make it accessible for transfer to the new computer.

Finally, while <u>transfer FTM 2019 to a new computer</u>, it's a good idea to check for updates. Family Tree Maker frequently releases patches and updates to improve performance and fix bugs. After installation, go to the "Check for Updates" option in the Help menu of FTM 2019 to ensure you are running the latest version of the software. Keeping your software up to date will also help avoid any potential compatibility issues with newer operating systems or features that may have been added since your original installation.
